Students who are officer candidates, campaign managers or voting delegates, **even if they are also competing, must be registered as a candidate, campaign manager or voting delegate for planning purposes.

Registration Procedure

All students, advisors and chaperones attending the conference are required to register for the conference using the online registration system (link will be provided after registration officially opens). **Conference registration must be submitted by February 10, 2025. Payment must be received by March 7, 2025, to avoid late fees.**

Ohio DECA recognizes its members are leaders and engaged students with competing priorities. Competitive event schedule change requests are never guaranteed. **Ohio DECA will attempt to facilitate schedule changes for requests made prior to Friday, February 28, 2025, at 5:00pm. Changes requested after this deadline will be assessed and invoiced a \$25.00 processing fee per request/change.** This includes day-of requests made at the Career Development Conference. Plan accordingly and have students check their schedules – *personal, school, and work* – before committing to competing at CDC.

Judge Recruitment

Ohio DECA is a career-technical student organization that serves nearly 6,000 students across the state of Ohio. For the Ohio Career Development Conference to run smoothly, 300+ judges* are needed across the two-day event.

Voting Delegates

Every Ohio chapter is eligible to bring up to five (5) non-competing students to attend the Career Development Conference to participate in workshops and to serve as a voting delegate for the annual State Officer Elections. Students serving as voting delegates must be registered as such (regardless of if they are also competing) and must attend all election sessions and events.

Conduct

Ohio DECA Career Development Conference attendees will adhere to the Delegate Conduct, Practices and Procedures outlined in the <u>ICDC Registration Guide</u> (page 36). Advisors are responsible for the conduct of their students and guests at all times through conference events. Failure to conduct oneself in the appropriate manner may result in dismissal from the conference, the premise, and disqualification from attending the International Career Development Conference.
